SAND's Journey So Far...



In August 2023, Kook launched its first activity, an ACE funded R & D on a new show using circus arts and theatre to explore the topic of Dementia against the backdrop of coastal erosion at the Landmark Theatre, North Devon. This culminated in a sharing of the WIP 'SAND' at the Landmark and at the Memory cafes in Barnstaple. SAND follows Kook's first fully ACE funded show Filibuster, which premieres at the Landmark Theatre, before a short tour.

SAND plays with comedy and tenderness, discovery and loss, laugher and adventure. It is a playful story of love and loyalty, against the backdrop of erosion, of both our landscape and sometimes our identities.

Meet Our Team

Sean Kempton

Co-Director

Sean is a hugely successful performer and director in circus and theatre. He continues to perform and develop work for Cirque Du Soleil and was an original cast member and comedy creator for Franco Dragones iconic Le Reve in Las Vegas. Most recent directorial work includes Underbelly's summer headline show at the South Bank London, National Romanian Circus' national tour, rewriting the clown content for the relaunch of Cirque Du Soleil's Kooza, and a co-commission by London Mime and Vamos theatre. Sean is currently working as a freelance director and creative artist on a number of projects across the UK.

Michaela O'Connor

Co-Director

Michaela is a trained physical actor, aerialist and director, whose work has taken her from the Royal Albert Hall and West End to Broadway. She has worked as a performer for Cirque Du Soleil, Dragone and Cameron Mackintosh, as well as a score of other leading companies internationally. Michaela specialises in highly physical ensemble circus work, having developed three major pieces in recent years for various venues in London. Michaela is also a core member of the National Centre for Circus Arts, where she is a leading member of the teaching faculty.

Tracey-Anne is a freelance director, producer and teacher, with a passion for building creative communities and advocating for the power of the arts. Most recently she has led the National Theatre's Schools Speak Up project for young people in North Devon.

Alongside Sand's R and D, we kick started a mission to embed ourselves as facilitating artists working within the community in North Devon, with the collaboration and support of other Devon made arts organisations, We worked closely with the Memory Café, a dementia focussed charity and organisation that supports families and other members of the community affected by this cruel disease. We are planning to build on this relationship and create an adapted version of SAND that is suitable for those affected by dementia, and that can be performed anywhere!



Our love of making work means we welcome a conversation about what wraparound experiences we could offer your community. We are experienced facilitators and practitioners with lots of ideas to support your engagement programme.

Open Door collaboration is a guiding principle for us. Inspired by the exposed backstage and scenery workshops at the National Theatre, we mirror this approach in the way we work. Our rehearsals and workshops are open to the public, inviting observation, curiosity and engagement, and striving to open hearts and minds to creativity, community and play.
